Lauren Bates grew up in Cape Town and has a Master's Degree in English Literature from UCT and a second Masters degree in Shakespeare and Creativity from the Shakespeare Institute in Stratford-Upon-Avon, both with Distinction. She is also a qualified Drama and English teacher. She has been performing in plays since childhood and directed her first full length play, *A*

Midsummer Night's Dream, when she was only 16. She went on to write and direct the winning one act play for her high school one act play festival, a play that then won the audience vote at a prestigious local festival. She has continued to teach and direct plays with young people ever since, as well as founding an Educational Theatre Company called Educasions, which takes plays into schools. She is passionate about the transformative power of the dramatic arts and the healing power of storytelling to help young people find their voices and unlock their full potential to grow into compassionate, responsible citizens. She has worked on creative projects with prisons, community upliftment initiatives and faith-based organizations to build hope and visibility for those who often go unseen.

Charmaine Ruvimbo Mujeri is a distinguished actor writer and theatre director with a prolific career in theatre and film.

Nominated in 2020 for an AMMA as Best Supporting Actress for her role as Zoe in the multi award winning film *Mirage*, best Newcomer and Best Supporting Actress for her portrayal as MacDuff in the Reps

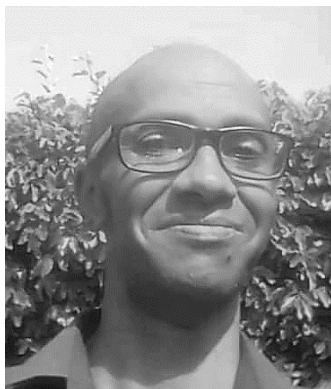


Theatre adaptation of Shakespeare's *Macbeth*. Mujeri is widely recognized for her performance as Charmaine in the award winning film *CookOff* which notably became the first Zimbabwean movie to be screened on Netflix. Her impressive repertoire includes roles in Danai Gurira's play *The Convert*, Blessing Hungwe's *Lovers in Time* as Kaguvi and Lucien Musamati's *Zuva Crumbling* where she was nominated Best Actress at the NAMAs. In 2023 she earned accolades at the Reps Theatre Awards for Best Actress in a Lead Role for her performance in *Medea* as Medea and Best Actress in a feature film in *Ngoda* as Bhuru. Born in Bulawayo in the 80s Mujeri is a fervent advocate for traditional Zimbabwean culture and religion contributing significantly through her roles in landmark plays and poetry performances at Harare international Festival of the Arts (HIFA), Shoko Festival and the International Images Film Festival. With over 15 years in the arts Mujeri has also worked with ICAPA Trust and contributed to the Anthology *Breaking the Silence* and was appointed Director for the James Curry Society in 2023. Her diverse career reflects a deep commitment to both her craft and cultural heritage.

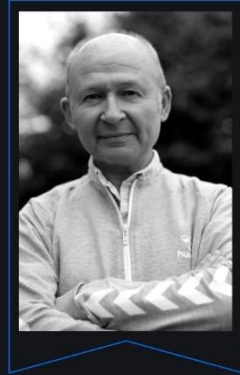
